Lynn Margaret Batten is a Professor with the School of Information Technology at Deakin University. She is also the Managing Director and CEO of IT Security Research Services which provides advice and direction on research in information technology security, and is an advisory board member for the company Access Governance Pty Ltd.

She was awarded a PhD by the University of Waterloo, Canada, is a Fellow of the Australian Computer Society, a graduate of the Australian Institute of Company Directors and a senior member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers. In 2007, she was awarded the Asia-Pacific Information Security Leadership Achievement by ISC².

Her research interests cover a broad set of areas in information security from cryptography to malicious software and digital forensics, as well as trust in clouds. She was instrumental in developing an undergraduate three year course in cyber security at Deakin University, Australia, which now graduates over 50 people every year.
